Our beloved partners joined in co-laboring to make many things possible, some of which include:

• Key friends invested on a monthly basis which allowed us to respond to invitations to equip indigenous leaders with our FAROS Leadership & Missions Curriculum in 5 nations!

- We hosted international volunteer teams provided opportunities for community outreaches including establishing a partnership with local school administrators in Palenque, Colombia to bring Parents & Students workshops on Girl's & Women's Menstrual Health & Bullying Awareness
- 3 Church plants were started including Lighthouse NTX, FAROS Palenque, & FAROS Santa Marta in Colombia
- Maintenance and preparation for the construction completion continues at Casa de Luz in Palenque, Colombia
- Mentorship & equipping resources have been provided for over 150 native pastors & leaders in different nations.
- We facilitated strategic leadership meetings and provided pastoral care for church leaders in different nations.



Casa de Luz Church Plant Activities

Pastor Catalina and volunteer team lead various activities on a weekly, monthly and annual basis including:

- Early Morning Prayer
- Children's Church
- Family meetings
- Fellowship Meals
- Birthday celebrations
- Couples' & Women's retreats
- Home visits: families, elderly, sick, widows
- National & International mission teams





During the children's church services, we sing, dance, play, and paint. We even cook together, wash dishes, and share jokes. We read the Bible together, we meditate on it, pray, cry out to God, and we celebrate one another's birthdays. Our year was simply full of a very good learning adventure, mutually for the children and volunteers. There is a genuine and natural flow of the Holy Spirit during this time. The children have been so touched and ministered to by the Holy Spirit, the truth is that I had not seen a revival, so great and so supernatural! They were so impacted that they wanted to tell their experience to their teachers, parents and to the adults who come to gatherings. It has been incredible.











Women's Health Retreat

Our Women's Health Retreat was a way of sharing the Gospel & get educated on topics often not spoken about!

20 women attended & participated.

Our guest speaker was: Bernice Gaspard, Social Worker from NY. She shared about her life stages & faith journey.

This year we invited 13 couples to come and learn God's original intent for marriage & family.


Each couple received their own Bible. (Donated by a church in Barranguilla)

Community Outreach & Education



In the month of October 2023, we held the first Girls & Women's health workshop on Period Poverty in the community, as a way to bring the dignity of Christ to the hearts of women in an area of much taboo, shame and lack.

On this occasion it was addressed to the parents of the community institution and was logistically scheduled by the directors of the institution, we had the attendance of about 150 parents and teachers. This did include some men (fathers) and this was in itself a victory, because historically the woman has been seen to lead in these spaces and the man little to be included in these topics of their daughters' lives.

We had the participation of different professionals to cover the different aspects of the areas of life impacted such as anatomically, emotionally & socially.

The school administrators asked us to return in 2024 and give a workshop to students & parents on Bullying & Period Poverty.



New Doors & a Fence...What's next?

















Elemir (Mincho) and the Casa de Luz team have been doing an amazing job taking care of the infrastructure and the grounds. The first floor is where teams currently stay and where activities are held. This year with your donations we were able to put doors on both bathrooms and all 3 bedrooms! It was also awesome to be able to secure the land by putting in a fence for more safety and privacy.

In March 2024, we received a donation to build a water tank for the first floor & purchase a water pump so that we can have more constant use of water.

We continue to dream with finishing the second floor for Family Counselling & small group area. Our goal for the backyard is to build a storage cabin, a two bedroom 1 bathroom tiny home, and a kiosk in the center garden area. We are praying for the Lords provision & timing.

Native Leadership & Missions Training

The Lord opened a beautiful door to Central America. We have enjoyed co-laboring with long-term Missionaries Larry and Marla Johnson in Chiquimula. They have been there for 30+ years and help native pastors with the construction of their own churches, biblical training of rural pastors, and establishing feeding centers for children in arid areas. We are honored to serve alongside them to help train their native pastors and leaders. We were able to implement FAROS Module 1: Identity & Sonship to over 150 pastors in various regions.

Our FAROS teams went three times! John went first to establish the relationship. Then, our FAROS staff member Jesu was also able to go on his first international outreach to serve in the feeding centers and on a prayer assignment with John. Finally, John, Susie, and our dear friend Rita Bear Gray from Canada joined forces to teach Mod 1 to native leaders and pastors. They were refreshed and many healed from wounds of the heart.
